As I have walked to voter's homes over the last four months, I distributed a questionnaire to citizens in our district asking your opinion on what are the most pressing problems in our community.


The response I received was overwhelming. Hundreds of people took the time to write in and I wanted to share the results with you. The chart to the right shows the breakdown of responses.

- Enhancing retail shopping throughout our community.

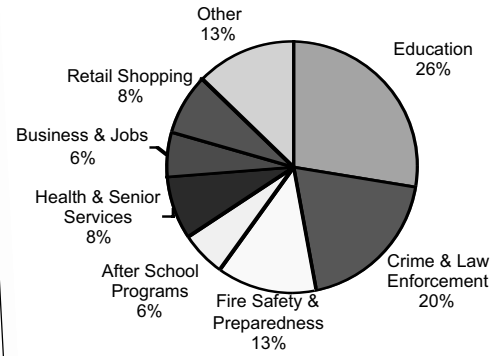
