# Decide for Yourself

There's a lot of controversy over the OakPAC (Oakland Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce) donations to David Stein. Here are the facts:


- Oakland passed donation limits to restrict the influence of big donors on elections: \$600 per individual and \$1100 per Political Action Committee.
- "Soft money" contributions like OakPAC's let big contributors hide their donations and evade the limits.
- OakPAC's \$27,000 for Stein is the largest documented soft money contribution to a candidate in Oakland's history. It paid for phone calls and two districtwide mailings for Stein.
